fulminates

- 1. Compounds having the structure RON=C:. So called because fulminic acid (actually $HC\equiv N^+-O^-$ formonitrile oxide) was previously considered to be HON=C:.
- 2. Salts of fulminic acid, e.g. $Na^{+}[-C \equiv N^{+}O^{-}]$.
