

imino carbenes

This term systematically means carbenes bearing an imino or *N*-substituted imino group, RN=, somewhere in the molecule. E.g. R–C:–CH₂C(=NR)R. It is listed here in order to warn against its misuse for alkylideneamino carbenes.
