stibines

SbH₃ and compounds derived from it by substituting one, two or three hydrogen atoms by hydrocarbyl groups R_3Sb . $RSbH_2$, R_2SbH and R_3Sb ($R \neq H$) are called primary, secondary and tertiary stibines, respectively. A specific stibine is preferably named as a substituted stibane. E.g. ($CH_2=CH$)₃Sb trivinylstibane.
