Cations having the structure RS^+ ($\text{R} \neq \text{H}$). This term is derived from sulfenic acids. The synonymous term sulfanylium ions is derived from sulfane, H_2S . E.g. CH_3S^+ methylsulfanylium or methanesulfenylium ion.
