sulfenyl radicals

Sulfur-centered radicals having the structure RS^{\cdot} (R \neq H). This term is derived from sulfenic acids. The synonymous term sulfanyl radicals is derived from sulfane, H₂S.

E.g. CH_3S^{-} methylsulfanyl or methanesulfenyl radical. An older synonymous term is alkylthio radical.
