

## altocumulus cloud

*in atmospheric chemistry*

A dappled layer of patch or cloud composed of flattened globules that may be arranged in groups, lines or waves collectively known as billows; 2000 - 6000 m; vertical velocities of 0.05 - 0.1 m s<sup>-1</sup>.
