

aminals

Compounds having two amino groups bonded to the same carbon, $R_2C(NR_2)_2$. Also called geminal diamines. [The term aminal has also been used, with consequent ambiguity, for α -amino ethers (hemiaminal ethers); such use is discouraged.]
