


amino sugars

Monosaccharides having one alcoholic hydroxy group (commonly but not necessarily in position 2) replaced by an amino group; systematically known as α -amino- α -deoxymonosaccharides. (Glycosylamines are excluded.)

E.g. D-glucosamine or 2-amino-2-deoxy-D-glucopyranose.
