By usage, the methylenediphenols, $\text{HO}\text{C}_6\text{H}_4\text{CH}_2\text{C}_6\text{H}_4\text{OH}$, commonly *p,p*-methylenediphenol, and their substitution products (generally derived from condensation of two equivalent amounts of a phenol with an aldehyde or ketone).
