Analogues of alkenes in which a doubly bonded carbon atom is replaced by a heteroatom, e.g. $\text{H}_2\text{Si}=\text{CH}_2$ methylidenesilane (silene less preferred), $\text{MeN}=\text{CH}_2$ *N*-methylmethanimine.
